THE BURIALS LAWS, 1896 AND 1937.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 14.

H. R. PALMER,

Governor.

Whereas in pursuance of Notification Nos. 65 and 78 published in Supplement No. 3 to *Gazettes* of the 25th March, 1937, and the 23rd April, 1937, Nos. 2575 and 2580, respectively, a fit and proper site has been registered in the books of the Land Registry Office as a common burial-ground for the burial of the dead by the Orthodox-Christian Communities of the villages of Lefka and Karavostasi, in the District of Nicosia:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 14 of the Burials Laws, 1896 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that, from and after the 8th day of May, 1939, no burial shall take place in the burial-ground in lieu whereof the new burial-ground above referred to has been provided.
