(2) Every such fee shall be paid to the Inspector.

Rule 57.—(1) The following fees shall be paid by every person exposing for sale any foodstuff in the market of foodstuffs, that is to say:—

(c) If the foodstuffs exposed for sale exceed 50p. in value ... - 3

(2) The fees in this rule prescribed shall be paid to the Inspector."

No. 12. The Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1938.

Rules made by the Village Health Commission of Klirou under Section 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1938, the Village Health Commission of Klirou hereby make the following Rules:—

1. These Rules may be cited as the Village Health (Klirou) Amendment Rules, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Klirou) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter called "the Principal Rules"), and the Principal Rules and these Rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Klirou) Rules, 1938 and 1939.

2. Part I of the Schedule to the Principal Rules is hereby amended to the deletion theoretical and the schedule to the Principal Rules is hereby amended

by the deletion therefrom of Rule 80.

3. Part II of the Schedule to the Principal Rules is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "Rules 1, 2, 21 and 77" and the substitution therefor of the words "Rules 1 and 2".
