THE SHIPPING DUES LAWS, 1917 AND 1932.

## ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1870

MADE UNDER SECTION 13.

A. B. WRIGHT,

Acting Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 13 of the Shipping Dues Laws, 1917 and 1932, His Excellency the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

There shall be exempt from the payment of all dues under the Shipping Dues Laws, 1917 and 1932, the following ships, that is to say,—

- (a) The special steamers of the Khedivial Mail Line in respect of six calls made or to be made by such steamers to Limassol during the months of June, July, August, September and October in the year 1939;
- (b) The steamers of the "Adriatica" Societa An. di Navigazione in respect of such calls as are made by such steamers during the months of June, July, August and September in the year 1939 direct from Palestine to Cyprus: Provided that the number of passengers landed on each such call shall exceed forty.
