THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1938.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1871

MADE UNDER SECTION 52.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 52 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1938, His Excellency the Acting Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Importation of Wheat and Flour (Restriction) Order, 1939.
- 2.—(a) The importation into the Colony of wheat and flour is hereby prohibited save under the authority of a licence in writing under the hand of the Director of Agriculture.
- (b) The grant of a licence to any person shall be in the absolute discretion of the Director of Agriculture and he may, with or without assigning any reason, grant or withhold the licence as he thinks fit or grant the licence subject to such terms and conditions as may be prescribed in the licence.
