THE BURIALS LAWS, 1896 AND 1937.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 1.

A. B. WRIGHT,

Acting Governor.

Whereas the burial-ground situated in the village of Menoyia, in the District of Larnaca, now in use by the Moslem Community for the burial of the dead, is insufficient for the requirements and dangerous to the health of the said village:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 1 of the Burials Laws, 1896 and 1937, His Excellency the Acting Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that a new burial-ground, in substitution for the burial-ground now in use as aforesaid, shall be provided under the provisions of the said Laws.
