THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS DEFENCE) REGULATIONS, 1939.

ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 43.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of Regulation 43 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) Regulations, 1939, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Kerosene) Amendment Order, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Kerosene) Order, 1939, (hereinafter Supplement) called "the Principal Order"), and the Principal Order and this Order No. 3: may together be cited as the Defence (Regulation of Sale Prices) (Kerosene) 5.9.1939. Orders, 1939.

2. Clause 2 of the Principal Order is hereby amended by the insertion of the following proviso at the end thereof:

"Provided that kerosene having a flash point of 150 degrees Fahrenheit of the brands known as "Rising Sun" and "Indian Head" may be sold at a maximum price of three piastres per tin above the prices shown in the third column of the Schedule hereto."
