These Regulations may be cited as the Quarantine (Public Health) Amendment Regulations, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Quarantine (Public Health) Regulations, 1935 to 1937, (hereinafter called "the Principal Regulations"), and the Principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Quarantine (Public Health) Regulations, 1935 to 1939.
- 2. The First Schedule to the Principal Regulations is hereby amended by the addition at the end thereof of the following disease as item 18:—

 "18. Whooping Cough."
