DECLARATION OF PENSIONABLE OFFICES.

THE LEPERS LAWS, 1891 AND 1932.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 10.

H. R. PALMER,

Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 10 of the Lepers Laws, 1891 and 1932, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to make and hereby makes the following Regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Leper Farm (Amendment) Regulations, 1939, and shall be read as one with the Leper Farm Regulations, 1932, (hereinafter called "the Principal Regulations"), and the Principal Regulations and these Regulations may together be cited as the Leper Farm Regulations, 1932 and 1939.
- 2. The following heading and regulations shall be inserted in the Principal Regulations immediately after Regulation 11 thereof:—

"Burial-Grounds.

11A. The land situated within the limits of the area of the Leper Farm and more particularly described in the First Schedule hereto is hereby appointed to be and shall henceforth be used as a new burial-ground for the burial of the dead of the Orthodox-Christian Community of the Leper Farm.

11B. From and after the 1st day of March, 1939, no burial shall take place in the old burial-ground situated within the limits of the area of the Leper Farm and more particularly described in the Second Schedule hereto.
