BY THE GOVERNOR.

A PROCLAMATION.

W. D. BATTERSHILL, Governor.

Whereas by a Proclamation made the 22nd day of September, 1938, and published in the Gazette of the 23rd day of September, 1938, (hereinafter called "the First Proclamation") it was ordered and proclaimed that on and after the 1st January, 1939, the boundary of the Town of Nicosia should be as set forth in Schedule A to the said Proclamation and that the Town of Nicosia comprised within the said boundary should be divided into quarters as set forth in Schedule B to the said Proclamation:

And whereas by a Proclamation dated the 30th day of December, 1938, and published in the *Gazette* of the 31st day of December, 1938, (hereinafter called "the Second Proclamation") it was ordered and proclaimed that the First Proclamation should be amended in order to postpone its coming into operation until the 1st day of January, 1940:

And whereas it has been made to appear to me desirable that the coming into operation of the First Proclamation should be further postponed for one year;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by section 17 of the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and otherwise, do hereby order and proclaim that the First Proclamation as amended by the Second Proclamation shall be further amended by the deletion of the words "1st day of January, 1940" appearing therein and by the substitution therefor of the words "1st day of January, 1941".

Given at Nicosia, this 27th day of December, 1939.
