THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS, 1936 TO 1938.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1854

MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1938, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

- 1. That the village of Lefkoniko, in the Famagusta District, shall be deleted from the Schedule to the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1938, as from the 1st day of April, 1939.
- 2. That any moneys in the Village Health Fund of Lefkoniko on the 1st day of April, 1939, shall be paid to the Commissioner of the District of Famagusta to be transferred by him, upon the Proclamation of the village of Lefkoniko as a Municipal Corporation, to the town fund of such Municipal Corporation.
