No. 372. THE SUMMER TIME LAW, 1940.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Summer Time Law, 1940, do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Summer Time (Amendment) Order, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Summer Time Order, 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Summer Time Orders, 1940.

No. 373. THE BURIALS LAWS, 1896 AND 1937.

Whereas the burial-ground situated in the village of Pano Kophinou, in the District of Larnaca, now in use by the Moslem Community for the burial of the dead, is insufficient for the requirements and dangerous to the health of the said village :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 1 of the Burials Laws, 1896 and 1937, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order and hereby orders that a new burial-ground, in substitution for the burial-ground now in use as aforesaid, shall be provided under the provisions of the said Laws.
