THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO 1940.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 1973

MADE UNDER SECTION 59.

W. D. Battershill, Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 59 of the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1940, do hereby order as follows:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods Prohibition (Amendment) Order, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Export of Goods Prohibition Order, 1940, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Supplement Order "), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited No. 3: as the Export of Goods Prohibition Orders, 1940.

- 2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended as follows:—
- (a) By the deletion therefrom of item 8 and the substitution therefor of the following item:
 - "8. Fruit (all descriptions) fresh or dried."
- (b) By the addition, after item 8, of the following item: "8A. Fruit juices."
- (c) By the addition, after item 12, of the following item: "12a. Onions."
- (d) By the addition, after item 16, of the following item:— "16a. Vinegar."
