THE POST OFFICE LAWS, 1881 TO 1933.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2007

MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

W D. BATTERSHILL,

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to order and it is hereby ordered as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage)

Order, 1941.
2. There shall be charged a combined Postage and Air fee, in addition to late and/or registration fees, at the rates set forth in the second and third columns of the Schedule hereto, on letters, printed papers, commercial papers, samples and postcards intended for transmission by air mail to any of the countries of destination enumerated in the first column of the said Schedule, such transmission to be effected-

(a) by surface route from the Colony to Egypt or Palestine; and (b) from Egypt or Palestine to the country of destination either wholly by air or partially by air and partially by surface route. 3. The Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Order, 1940, is hereby revoked.

NOTICE No. 16 UNDER CLAUSE 13.

The Schedule is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of Part 24 and the substitution therefor of the following part with effect from the 4th January, 1941:—
