ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as the Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 8) 1942, I hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Newsprint Control) Amendment Order, 1942, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Newsprint Control) Order, 1940 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Order"), and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Newsprint Control) Orders, 1940 and 1942.
- 2. Clause 2 of the principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the words "and any part of such paper" after the word "newspaper" in line 8.
