

No. 318. THE ELEMENTARY EDUCATION LAWS, 1933 TO 1944.**NOTICE UNDER SECTION 74 (1).**

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 74 (1) of the Elementary Education Laws, 1933 to 1944, and otherwise, His Excellency the Governor is pleased to direct and it is hereby directed that the tax mentioned in section 65 of the said Laws payable by the Maronite tax payers of the villages mentioned in the first column of the Schedule hereto shall be increased by the rate per thousand mentioned in the second column of the said Schedule hereto to provide the amount required for the payment of loans or annual maintenance of the Maronite schools of the said villages respectively.

No. 319. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 2) 1944.**ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.**

In exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1944, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Control of Local Hides and Local Leather) (Amendment) Order, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Defence (Control of Local Hides and Local Leather) Order, 1943, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") and the principal Order and this Order may together be cited as the Defence (Control of Local Hides and Local Leather) Orders, 1943 and 1944.

2. Sub-clause (1) of clause 8 of the principal Order is hereby deleted and the following sub-clause substituted therefor:—

"(1) Every butcher, not being a licensed dealer, shall, within the times specified in sub-clause (2) of this clause, after the slaughter—

(a) of any she-goat, lamb, kid, cow, ox, calf or heifer, dispose of the hide of such animal to a licensed dealer;

(b) of any he-goat, sell the hide of such animal to me or any person authorized by me in writing in that behalf, and remove or cause such hide to be removed to a place of storage licensed by me or on my behalf."

No. 320. THE DEFENCE REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 2) 1944.**ORDER MADE BY THE COMPETENT AUTHORITY UNDER REGULATION 61.**

Whereas it appears to me that the regulation of bakeries is essential to the life of the community:

Now therefore in exercise of the powers vested in me by virtue of my appointment by the Governor as Competent Authority for the purposes of regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1944, I hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Defence (Bakeries Regulation) Order, 1944.

2. In this Order—

“bakery” means any building, room or place used for or connected with the preparation, making or baking of bread for sale whether by retail or wholesale :

“registered baker” means any person registered as a baker under the Defence (Control of Bakeries and Bread) Orders, 1942 and 1943, and includes any person registered or deemed to be a registered baker under the Defence (Bakery and Bread) Orders, 1942 to (No. 3) 1942.

3. The Commissioner of each district may by an order under his hand addressed to any registered baker working a bakery within his district prescribe—

(a) the quantity of bread which shall be baked in such bakery during the period or periods mentioned in such order ;

(b) the price at which bread baked in such bakery may be sold or offered for sale ;

(c) the hours during which such bakery shall remain open, and may give such incidental directions as appear to him to be necessary or expedient in connection with such order.

4. For the purpose of the effectual regulation of bakeries and for the purpose of this Order I hereby delegate to the Commissioner of each district all the powers conferred upon me in that behalf by regulation 61 of the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1944, to hold and exercise within his district.

5. Any person who—

(a) acts in contravention of, or fails to comply with, any order or direction given under clause 3 of this Order :

(b) knowingly misleads or otherwise interferes with or impedes any person exercising any powers or performing any duties under the provisions of this Order,

is liable to the penalties prescribed in the Defence Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1944.
