No. 391. THE EMERGENCY POWERS (DEFENCE) ACTS, 1939 AND 1940.

REGULATIONS MADE BY THE ACTING GOVERNOR.

I, the Acting Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred on the Governor by the Emergency Powers (Defence) Acts, 1939 and 1940, as extended to the Colony by the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) Order in Council, 1939, the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1940, and the Emergency Powers (Colonial Defence) (Amendment) Order in Council, 1942, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Defence (Cyprus Pensions Orders and Laws, 1929 to 1944) Regulations, 1944, and shall be read and construed as one with the Cyprus Pensions Orders and Laws, 1929 to 1944 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order").

(2) The Interpretation Law, 1935, shall apply to the interpretation of these regulations as it applies to the interpretation of a Law.

2. During the continuance in force of these regulations and notwithstanding anything in sub-section (2) of section 9 of the Order contained, the Governor in Council may, whenever he thinks fit, extend the period of service in Cyprus of any constable beyond the compulsory retiring age of fifty-five years.

3. These regulations shall be deemed to have been made on the 1st day of January, 1944.
