RULES MADE UNDER ARTICLE XV.

I, the Governor, in exercise of the powers conferred by Article XV of the Cyprus Currency Notes Order and Law, 1928 and 1935, as amended by the Defence (Amendment of the Cyprus Currency Notes Order and Law, 1928 and 1935) Regulations, 1942, with the approval of the Secretary of State, do hereby make the following rules :-

Short title. Gazettes: Supplement No. 3: 29. 1.1942 18. 2.1943 4, 3.1943 11.11.1943.

1. These rules may be cited as the Cyprus Currency Notes (Amendment) Rules, 1944, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus Currency Notes Rules, 1942 to (No. 3) 1943, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Cyprus Currency Notes Rules, 1942 to 1944.

Amendment of rule 26 of Rules.

2. Rule 26 of the principal Rules is hereby amended as follows:-

(a) by the deletion of paragraph (1) thereof and the substitution therefor of the principal the following paragraph:-

"(1) The denominations and sizes of currency notes which may be issued under the Order and Law shall be as follows:—
