A PROCLAMATION.

C. C. WOOLLEY.

Governor.

Whereas by a Proclamation made on the 5th day of October, 1943. (hereinafter Gazettes: referred to as "the First Proclamation"), as amended by the Proclamations made Supplement the 26th day of October, 1943, and 21st day of December, 1943, it was ordered No. 3: and proclaimed that from and after the 1st January, 1944, the boundary of the town of Nicosia should be as set forth in Schedule A to the First Proclamation and that 28.10.1943 the town of Nicosia comprised within the said boundary should be divided into 23.12.1943 quarters as set forth in Schedule B to the said Proclamation:

And whereas it has been made to appear to me desirable to amend Schedule B

to the First Proclamation:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by Section 17 of the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and of every other power hereunto enabling, I hereby order and proclaim that Schedule B to the First Proclamation shall be amended as follows:

(1) By the deletion of paragraph 6 of Schedule B to the First Proclamation and the substitution therefor of the following:—
6. The Ayios Andreas Quarter comprising—

(a) the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties

comprised within the Top Khane Quarter; and (b) the properties within the following boundary hitherto forming part of the

Arab Ahmed Quarter, that is to say-

The boundary commences at the south-western corner of plot No. 90, block No. 27 of Arab Ahmed Quarter, Nicosia, at the junction of Tennyson Road with Hermocles Road and proceeds eastwards along the latter road to the left bank of the river Pedieos; thence eastwards crossing the said river to the most western point of plot No. 49 of the said block on a track; thence north-eastwards along the southern boundary of the said track to the most northern point of plot No. 47 of the said block on Shakespeare Road; thence south-eastwards along the said road to its junction with King Edward VII Road; thence south eastwards along the said road to its junction with Cinyras Road; thence westwards along the said road to the western end of the Troodos Road bridge over the river Pedieos; thence northwards along Tennyson Road to the point of commencement, all which said area is more particularly defined as the area edged red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1308.

(2) By the deletion of sub paragraph (a) of paragraph 7 of Schedule B to the

First Proclamation and the substitution therefor of the following:

(a) the properties which at the date of the commencement of this Proclamation are recorded in the books of the Land Registry Office as the properties comprised within the quarter aforesaid with the exception of the properties within the following boundary (now comprised in the Ayios Andreas

Quarter) that is to say-The boundary commences at the south western corner of plot No. 90, block No. 27 of Arab Ahmed Quarter, Nicosia, at the junction of Tennyson Road with Hermocles Road and proceeds eastwards along the latter road to the left bank of the river Pedieos; thence eastwards crossing the said river to the most western point of plot No. 49 of the said block on a track; thence north-eastwards along the southern boundary of the said track to the most northern point of plot No. 47 of the said block on Shakespeare Road; thence south eastwards along the said road to its junction with King Edward VII Road; thence south eastwards along the said road to its junction with Cinyras Road; thence westwards along the said road to the western end of the Troodos Road bridge over the river Pedieos; thence northwards along Tennyson Road to the point of commencement, all which said area is more particularly defined as the area edged red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1308.

THE CUSTOMS LAWS, 1936 TO (No. 2) 1944.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 58 (2).

C. C. WOOLLEY, Governor.

I, the Governor in Council, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 58 (2) of the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1944, and of every other power thereunto enabling, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. These regulations may be cited as the Exportation of Animals (Amendment) Regulations, 1945, and shall be read as one with the Exportation of Animals Regulations, 1930, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"), and the principal Regulations and these regulations may together be cited as the Exportation of Animals Regulations, 1930 and 1945.

2. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the Second and Third Schedules and the substitution therefor of the following Schedules, respectively:—

"SECOND SCHEDULE. FEES FOR HEALTH CERTIFICATES. For every Health Certificate in respect ofs. p.(a) Each horse, mule, donkey, camel, ox or pig ... 2 0 0 (b) Each sheep or goat or other animal not enumerated in (a) ... THIRD SCHEDULE. FEES FOR LAIRAGE. For lairage in a Port Lairage for every twenty-four hours or part thereof in respect of—
