In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 of the Post Office Laws, 1881 to 1933, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Gazettes:<br/>Suppl. No. 3) Order, 1948, and shall be read as one with<br/>the Post Office (Air Mail Rate of Postage) Orders, 1946 to 1948<br/>8. 8.1946<br/>(hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order"), and the principal 27.12.1946<br/>Order and this Order may together be cited as the Post Office (Air Mail<br/>17. 4.1947<br/>Rate of Postage) Orders, 1946 to (No. 3) 1948.7.12.1946<br/>19. 6.1947<br/>19. 2.1948
