THE PUBLIC HEALTH (VILLAGES) LAWS; 1936 TO 1943.

The following rules made by the Village Health Commission of Ayios Seryios in the District of Famagusta, and approved by the Commissioner, are published in the *Gazette*.

RULES MADE BY THE VILLAGE HEALTH COMMISSION OF AYIOS SERIYIOS
UNDER SECTION 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them under section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Laws, 1936 to 1943, the Village Health Commission of Ayios Seryios hereby make the following rules :—

1. These rules may be cited as the Village Health (Ayios Seryios) (Amendment) Rules, 1948, and shall be read as one with the Village Health (Ayios Seryios) Rules, 1938 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Rules"), and the principal Rules and these rules may together be cited as the Village Health (Ayios Seryios) Rules, 1938 and 1948. *Gazette :*

2. Rules 20, 46 and 54 of the principal Rules are hereby repealed and the following rules substituted therefor, respectively :—

" *Rule 20.*—The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by the owner or the person slaughtering any animal in the slaughter-house :—

(a) for every bullock, camel, cow or ox	3	0
(b) for every goat, sheep, kid or lamb above 10 okes carcass weight	—	5
(c) for every goat, sheep, kid or lamb of 10 okes or under carcass weight	—	4.

Rule 46.—The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by every person exposing for sale any fresh meat in the meat market, that is to say :—

(a) for every carcass of sheep, goat, kid or lamb or part thereof of 10 okes or under carcass weight	—	3
(b) for every carcass of sheep, goat, kid or lamb of over 10 okes carcass weight	—	4
(c) for every carcass of ox, camel, cow or bullock or part thereof	2	0

Rule 54.—The following fees shall be paid to the Inspector by the owner of or the person exposing for sale any carcass of swine or fresh pork in the pork market, that is to say :—

(a) for every carcass of pig, swine or their young ones, over 30 okes carcass weight	5	0
(b) for every carcass of pig, swine or their young ones, of 30 okes or under carcass weight.. ..	3	0"
