**A PROCLAMATION.**

**WINSTER,**

*Governor.*

Whereas it is expedient that the boundaries of the village of Ora in the District of Larnaca should be altered, particularly with the object of the inclusion therein of the localities known as Drapia and Parsada.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1937, and otherwise, I, Reginald Thomas Herbert, Baron Winster of Witherslack, Privy Counsellor, Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Cyprus, do hereby order and proclaim that from and after the 1st day of July, 1948, the boundary of the village of Ora in the District of Larnaca shall be as set out in the Schedule hereto :

**SCHEDULE.**

The boundary commences at the north-eastern corner of plot No. 425 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLVIII.23 on the boundary between the village of Ayii Vavatsinias and the village of Ora and proceeds north-eastwards and eastwards along the said boundary to its junction with the southern boundary of the village of Vavatsinia; thence south-eastwards along the said boundary to its junction with the western boundary of the village of Layia; thence southwards along the said boundary to the most southern point of the village of Layia; thence north-eastwards along the south-eastern boundary of the said village to its junction with the south-western boundary of the village of Vavla; thence south-eastwards along the said boundary to its junction with the western boundary of the village of Tokhni; thence southwards along the said boundary to its junction with the northern boundary of the village of Kalavastos; thence westwards along the said boundary to its junction with the boundary between the District of Larnaca and the District of Limassol; thence north-westwards along the said boundary to its junction with the boundary of the village of Melini; thence eastwards and northwards along the eastern boundary of the said village to the point of commencement, all of which said area is shown bordered in red on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1387.

NOTE.—The localities known as Drapia and Parsada, are included in the above boundaries.
