- (a) by the insertion therein in the proper alphabetical order of the words "Perakhorio-Nisou" and "Potamia-Ayios Sozomenos" in column 2 under the heading "Nicosia District" in respect of the Greek-Orthodox religious community;
- (b) by the deletion therefrom of the words "Dhromolaxia-Meneou" in column 2 under the heading "Larnaca District" in respect of the Greek-Orthodox religious community;
- (c) by the insertion therein in the proper alphabetical order of the words "Argaki-Morphou" in column 2 under the heading "Nicosia District" in respect of the Moslem religious community :
- (d) by the deletion therefrom of the words "Skylloura-Ayios Vasilios" in column 2 under the heading "Nicosia District" and "Lemba-Kissonerga" in column $\tilde{2}$ under the heading " Paphos District" in respect of the Moslem religious community, and the substitution therefor of the words "Skylloura-Avios Vasilios-Ayia Marina Skyllouras" and "Lemba-Kissonerga-Emba ", respectively.
