(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 7 OF THE EMERGENCY POWERS (CYPRUS
DEFENCE) (FINANCE) REGULATIONS, 1940 TO (No. 2) 1941.

1. In exercise of the powers vested in me by regulation 7 of the Emergency Powers (Cyprus Defence) (Finance) Regulations, 1940 to (No. 2) 1941, mentioned in item 1 of the Second Schedule to the Supplies and Services (Transitional Powers) (Cyprus) Order, 1946, I, the Governor, do hereby designate the following foreign currency to be foreign currency for the purpose of the said regulation, that is to say :—
