

No. 332. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 6.

WINSTER,

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 6 of the Land Acquisition Laws, 1899 to 1947, and with reference to the Notification dated the 9th day of March, 1948, and published under No. 108 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 18th March, 1948, relating to the establishment of certain installations for use by His Majesty's Air Force in or near the Dherinia village, in the District of Famagusta, the cost whereof is to be borne by His Majesty's Air Force Authorities, I, the Governor, do hereby sanction the acquisition, under the provisions of the aforesaid Laws, of the immovable properties situated in or near the village of Dherinia, particulars whereof are specifically set out in the Notice of the Commissioner of Famagusta published under Notification No. 128 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 1st April, 1948, to vest and be registered in the name of His Majesty's Air Force Authorities, SUBJECT only to any rights of way which may exist on the date hereof on any paths or roads that may traverse the area covered by the lands thus acquired being reserved for the public and recorded in the Land Registry Office.

No. 333.**THE COMPANIES (LIMITED LIABILITY) LAWS, 1922 TO 1944.**

LICENCE UNDER SECTION 20.

Whereas it has been proved to the satisfaction of His Excellency the Governor that the Association of the Catholic Community which is about to be formed as a limited company under the Companies (Limited Liability) Laws, 1922 to 1944, is to be formed for the purpose of promoting objects of the nature contemplated by section 20 of the said Laws, and that it is the intention of the said Association that the profits, if any, or the income or property of the Association, whencesoever derived, shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Association, as set forth in the Memorandum of Association of the said Association and that no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly, by way of dividend or bonus or otherwise howsoever by way of profit to its members or to any of them or to any person claiming through any of them:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in the Governor by section 20 of the Companies (Limited Liability) Laws, 1922 to 1944, and in consideration of the provisions and subject to the conditions contained in the Memorandum of Association of the said Association, as subscribed by seven members thereof and approved by the Court, His Excellency the Governor does by this licence direct the Association of the Catholic Community to be registered with limited liability, without the addition of the word "Limited" to its name.
