**THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS (RETAILERS
CLOSING HOURS) ORDER, 1945.**

DIRECTION BY THE COMMISSIONER OF LARNACA UNDER CLAUSE 6 (a).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by clause 6 (a) of the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors (Retailers Closing Hours) Order, 1945, I hereby direct that, notwithstanding anything in the said Order contained, all licensed premises situate within the Municipality of Larnaca and within the villages of Aradhippou, Alaminos, Anaphotia, Alethriko, Anglisidhes, Pano-Lefkara, Ayia Anna, Ayios Theodoros, Vavla, Dhromolaxia, Zyyi, Kalavasos, Kalokhorio, Kato-Dhrys, Kellia, Kiti, Kophinou, Kato-Lefkara, Livadhia, Layia, Maroni, Mazotos, Melini, Meneou, Menoyia, Ora, Voroklini, Perivolia, Pyla, Pyrga, Skarinou, Tersephanou, Tokhni, Khirokitia and Psematismenos, in the District of Larnaca, shall be closed and remain closed from sunrise to 8 p.m. on the 8th day of February, 1948.

2. This direction shall not apply to any licensed premises the licensee of which is a person not belonging to the Greek-Orthodox Church.
