THE CYPRUS GOVERNMENT RAILWAY LAW, 1906.

AUTHORIZATIONS GRANTED UNDER SECTION 4.

No. 86. THE LAND ACQUISITION LAWS, 1899 TO 1947.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 5.

With reference to the Notification published under No. 52 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* No. 3355 of 12th February, 1948, notice is hereby given that the following lands are required by the Governor for the undertaking of public utility mentioned in that Notification :—

All that area of land situated in the village of Lysi, in the District of Famagusta, comprising 4½ donums or thereabouts, bounded on all sides by private property and including part of plots Nos. 178, 179, 180, 181, 245, 228, 244, 229, 230, 231, 232 and 233 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXXII.18E, part of plots Nos. 504, 503, 490, 489 and 491 of the Government Survey Plan No. XXXII.10E, more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan marked "Lysi-Arsos Road" and dated 1st February, 1948, deposited with the Commissioner of Famagusta.

The said area is at present occupied by a road constructed by the War Department.

2. Any person claiming to have any right or interest in the said lands is required within six weeks from the date of the notice to send to me a statement of his right and interest and of the evidence thereof, and of any claim made by him in respect of such right or interest.

3. The Governor is willing to treat for the acquisition of the said lands.

4. A plan showing the lands described above is available for inspection at my office in Famagusta.
