## THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATIONS LAW. CAP. 252 AND LAW II OF 1950.

Bye-laws made by the Council of the Municipal Corporation OF LAPITHOS.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by the Municipal Corporations Cap. 252. Law, and otherwise, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of Lapithos 11 of 1950 hereby make the following bye-laws:-

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Lapithos) Gazettes: (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Municipal 13.11.1931 Corporation (Lapithos) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1945 (hereinafter referred to as Suppl. No. 3: "the principal Bye-laws") and the principal Bye-laws and these bye-laws 21. 6.1945 may together be cited as the Municipal Corporation (Lapithos) Bye-laws, 1931 to 1951.
