THE PENSIONS LAW. CAP. 288 AND LAW 4 OF 1952.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2589 MADE UNDER SECTION 2 (1).

A. B. WRIGHT,

Governor.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 2(1) of the Pensions Law, I, the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby order as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Pensionable Offices (Declaration and Consolidation) Order, 1952.

2. The offices set out in the Schedule hereto are declared to be pensionable offices for the purposes of the above Law.

3. All offices at any time hitherto declared pensionable other than the offices set out in the Schedule hereto are declared to be no longer pensionable, due regard being had to existing rights.
