Rules made by the Village Health Commission of Platanistasa under Section 9.

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 9 of the Public Health (Villages) Law, the Village Health Commission of Platanistasa hereby make the following rules:—

(b) For every carcass of a young lamb or kid or part thereof - 4

5. Rule 54 of the principal Rules is hereby repealed and the following

market, that is to say, for every carcass of swine or part thereof or portion of fresh pork, 2 shillings.
