THE FORESHORE PROTECTION LAW. CAP. 92.

NOTICE UNDER SECTION 3 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 3 (1) of the Foreshore Protection Law, I do hereby absolutely prohibit—

Cap. 92.

- (a) the removal of stones, shingle, gravel and sand or other substance from all parts of the foreshore lying within the area described in the Schedule hereto;
- (b) the dumping of any rubble, rubbish, sweeping, litter, nightsoil or other refuse on any part of the foreshore within the area described in the Schedule hereto.

SCHEDULE.

Ormidhia Village.

The foreshore commences at the mouth of a stream, which stream forms the eastern boundary of plot No. 148.4 of the Government Survey Plan No. XLI.22, locality "Meridji" and proceeds eastwards along the highwater mark for a distance of 840 yards or thereabouts to a point due south of the south-western corner of plot No. 110 of the said plan, locality "Aghudhin", and includes any land within a distance of fifty yards of the said highwater mark. The said foreshore is more particularly defined as the area coloured yellow on the Government Survey Plan Serial No. 1573, a copy of which is available for inspection at the Office of the Commissioner, Larnaca.

THE SHEEP AND GOATS (SHEPHERDS' LICENSING AND CONTROL) LAW.

CAP. 157.

Notice under Section 12.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 12 of the Sheep and Goats (Shepherds' Licensing and Control) Law, I hereby direct that during the period between the 10th February, 1953, and the 30th April, 1953, flocks within the area of Kiti and Sophtadhes, in the District of Larnaca, shall, between the hours of sunset and sunrise, be kept inside an enclosure and not taken outside an enclosure:

Provided that nothing in this notice contained shall prevent the driving of any flock, under the proper charge of a licensed shepherd, from one village area to another, along any public road, at any hour.
