# THE IRRIGATION (PRIVATE WATER) ASSOCIATION LAW, 1949.

In pursuance of the provisions of sub-section (3) of section 12 of the Irrigation (Private Water) Association Law, 1949, the following rules made by the Committee of the Irrigation Association of Karavas ("Ayios Andreas" Water), in the District of Kyrenia, are published in the Gazette.

> IRRIGATION ASSOCIATION OF KARAVAS ("AYIOS ANDREAS" WATER). Rules.

- 1. These rules may be cited as the Irrigation Association of Karavas ("Ayios Andreas" Water) Rules, 1953.

2. In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires—
"Commissioner" means the Commissioner of the District of Kyrenia;
"Committee" means the Committee of the Irrigation Association;
"Irrigation Association" means the Irrigation Association of Karavas ("Ayios Andreas" Water);

means the Irrigation (Private Water) Association Law, 1949;

"List" means the list of the names and residences of the proprietors and of the extent of the interest of each proprietor in the water, as finally settled in accordance with the provisions of section 11 of the Law;

"Water" means the water commonly known as "Ayios Andreas" Water; "Works" means the irrigation works of the Irrigation Association.

3. The present Committee shall hold office for a period of three years beginning on the 1st February, 1953. The election of each subsequent Committee shall take place in the manner hereinafter provided every third year in the first week of the month of February and it shall hold office for a period of three years from the date of the expiration of the period of office of the previous Committee.
