THE EMERGENCY POWERS ORDERS IN COUNCIL, 1939 AND 1956.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 6.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 6 of the Emergency Powers Orders in Council, 1939 and 1956, I, the Governor, do hereby make the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Amendment of the Customs Management Regulations) Regulations, 1956.
2. During the continuance in force of these Regulations items (1) and (5) appearing under Class I—Imported Goods Division (A) of the Schedule to the Customs Management Regulations, 1954 and 1955, shall be read and construed as if they were amended by the substitution for the figure “5” appearing opposite each of the said items of the figure “10”.

Made at Nicosia, this 23rd day of October, 1956.

EXPLANATORY NOTE.

(This note is not part of the Order but is intended to indicate its general purport).

These Emergency Regulations amend the Customs Management Regulations, 1954 to 1955, by doubling the storage charges on unpackaged goods in harbour areas.
