

No. 1003. THE SPECIAL COURT LAWS, 1955 TO 1956.**ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2880**

MADE UNDER SECTION 18.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by the proviso to section 18 of the Special Court Laws, 1955 to 1956, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Special Court (Continuance) Order, 1956.

2. The Special Court Laws, 1955 to 1956, shall continue in operation for a period of six months from the date on which they would otherwise expire, that is until the 30th day of April, 1957, and shall then expire unless continued in force for any further period or periods of six months by the Governor in Council, by Order published in the *Gazette*, under the provisions of the proviso to section 18 of the said Laws.
