No. 937. THE SECONDARY EDUCATION LAW.

CAP. 205 AND LAWS 15 OF 1950, 18 OF 1952, 20 OF 1954 AND 26 OF 1956.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 31.

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 31 of the Secondary Education Law, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Secondary Education (Exemption) Order, 1956.

2. Secondary schools which were struck off the Register of Secondary Schools under section 15 of the Secondary Education Law during the School Year 1955/56 and the re-registration of which has now been approved by the Governor, shall be exempt from making formal application for registration under the provisions of section 6 of the said Law.

**THE SUPPLIES AND SERVICES (TRANSITIONAL POWERS)
(CYPRUS) ORDER, 1946.**

**REVOCATION OF ORDERS MADE BY THE GOVERNOR
UNDER DEFENCE REGULATION 64.**
