**No. 173. THE AGRICULTURAL PRODUCE (EXPORT)
REGULATIONS, 1956.****NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 20 (b).*****Packing Specifications for Perishables.***

Gazette:
Suppl. No. 3: In exercise of the powers vested in me by Regulation 20 (b) of the
20. 1.1956. Agricultural Produce (Export) Regulations, 1956, I, the Director of Commerce and Industry, do hereby direct as follows:—

PART I.—CITRUS FRUIT.

1. *Citrus fruit* of any type intended for export to any destination shall not be packed except in one of the following manners:—

(i) In new wooden cases conforming with the provisions of Regulations 5 and 40 of the Regulations, made of wood of the following thicknesses:—

End and centre partitions	16 mm.
Top and bottom staves	7 mm.
Side Staves	8 mm ; or

(ii) In cartons.

2. *Oval Oranges, Valencia Oranges, Round Oranges, Bitter Oranges and Grapefruit* shall be packed—

- (i) In "Standard" cases, having an internal height of 27, 28 or 29 cm.; an internal width of 34 cm. and an external length of 68 cm.; or
- (ii) In cartons of specifications and dimensions approved by the Director.

3. *Oval Oranges* having a circumference of 19 cm. to 25 cm. shall be packed in "Standard" cases with counts of 100, 120, 150, 180, 210 or 240. Counts 100 and 120 shall be packed in four layers; all other counts shall be packed in five layers.

4. *Valencia Oranges, Round Oranges and Bitter Oranges* having a circumference of 18.5 to 25 cm. shall be packed in "Standard" cases with counts of 100, 120, 150, 180, 210, 240 or 270. Counts 100 and 120 shall be packed in four layers; all other counts shall be packed in five layers;

5. *Grapefruit* having a circumference of 24 cm. and over shall be packed in "Standard" cases with counts of 64, 80, 96, 112, 128 or 140 packed in four layers.

6. *Sour Lemons* shall be packed—

- (i)—(a) In "Standard" cases as prescribed in paragraph 2 above; or
- (b) In "Half Standard" cases having an internal height of 15, 16, 17 or 18 cm., an internal width of 34 cm. and an external length of 68 cm.; or

(ii) In cartons of specifications and dimensions approved by the Director.

7. *Sour Lemons* shall be packed with the following counts:—

- (i) In "Standard" cases with counts of 150, 180, 210, 240, 270, 300 and 336. Count 336 shall be packed in six layers; all other counts shall be packed in five layers; or
- (ii) In "Half-Standard" cases with counts of 90, 108, 126, 144, 162, 180 and 224. Count 224 shall be packed in four layers in cases not less than 17 cm. in height; all other counts shall be packed in three layers.

8. *Clementines and Mandarines* shall be packed—

- (i) In cases of the following dimensions:—

Internal height	14 cm.
Internal width	30 cm.
External length	62½ cm.

- (ii) In cartons of specifications and dimensions approved by the Director.

PART II.—GRAPES.

9. Grapes intended for export to any destination shall be packed in one of the following manners:—

- (i) In new trays conforming with the provisions of Regulations 5 and 47 of the Regulations and also with the following specifications:—

(a) The trays shall be made of 14 pieces of timber.

(b) The trays shall be of the following dimensions:—

Internal height of ends	8 cm.
Internal width	34 cm.
External length	50 cm.

(c) The trays shall be made of wood of the following thicknesses:

Ends	9 mm.
Side staves	6 mm.
Bottom staves	5 mm.

(d) The trays shall at each side be made of one single piece of timber; the bottom of the tray shall be constructed of four pieces of timber. At either side of the bottom of the tray there shall be one cleat. In the internal corners of the

tray there shall be triangular pieces of timber which shall protrude in such a way so as to fit the space left at the end of the bottom cleats.

- (ii) In cases conforming with the provisions of Regulations 5 and 47 of the Regulations and with the following specifications :—

- (a) The cases shall have the following dimensions :—

Internal height	14 cm.
Internal width	30 cm.
External length	46 cm.

- (b) The cases shall be made of wood of the following minimum thicknesses :—

End pieces	14 mm.
Top, bottom and side staves	5 mm.

- (c) The cases shall have two timber bars fixed on top of the lid to the satisfaction of the inspector :

Provided that sultana grapes shall not be exported in cases ;

- (iii) In cartons of specifications and dimensions approved by the Director.

PART III.—MELONS.

10. *Water Melons* intended for export to any destination shall be packed in one of the following manners :—

- (i) In new trays conforming with the provisions of Regulations 5 and 47 of the Regulations and also with the following specifications :—

- (a) The trays shall be made of wood of the following thicknesses :—

Ends	12 mm.
Bottom and sides	6 mm.

- (b) The trays shall be of the following dimensions :—

Internal height of ends	18 to 20 cm.
Internal width	40 cm.
External length	61 cm.

- (c) The trays shall at either side of the bottom have one cleat and in the internal corners of the tray there shall be triangular pieces of timber which shall protrude in such a way as to fit the space left at the end of the bottom cleat ; or

- (ii) In cartons of specifications and dimensions approved by the Director.

11. *Musk Melons, including Honeydew Melons*, intended for export to any destination shall be packed in one of the following manners :—

- (i) In trays as prescribed in clause 10 above ; or

- (ii) In cases conforming with the provisions of Regulations 5 and 47 of the Regulations and also with the following specifications :—

- (a) The cases shall have the following dimensions :—

Internal height of ends	16 to 22 cm.
Internal width	37 cm.
External length	61 cm.

- (b) The cases shall be made of wood of the following thicknesses :—

Ends	16 mm.
Top, bottom and side staves	7 mm.

- (c) The cases shall be fastened with two wire or strip metal bands to the satisfaction of the inspector ; or

- (iii) In cartons of specifications and dimensions approved by the Director

PART IV.—POMEGRANATES.

12. *Pomegranates* intended for export to the United Kingdom or any European port outside the Mediterranean Sea shall be packed in one of the following manners :—

- (i) In cases having an internal height of 16 to 22 cm., an internal width of 34 cm. and an external length of 68 cm., having counts of 40 to 100 with a net weight not less than 14 kilos (say

31 lbs.) and not more than 18 kilos (say 40 lbs.). The cases shall be made of wood of the following dimensions :—

End and centre partitions	16 mm.
Top, bottom and side staves	7 mm.

- (ii) In crates, trays or cartons of specifications and dimensions approved by the Director.

13. *Pomegranates* intended for export to any destination other than the United Kingdom or any European port outside the Mediterranean Sea shall be packed either (i) as prescribed in paragraph 12 ; or (ii) in strong baskets, of a type and size approved by the inspector, lined with paper and of a net weight not exceeding 25 kilos (56 lbs.).

14. *Pomegranates* intended for export to ports of the Mediterranean Sea and not for transshipment to any other destination shall be packed either (i) as prescribed in paragraph 13 or (ii) in one of the following manners :—

- (a) In new strong baskets, of a type and size approved by the inspector, lined with paper and of a net weight not exceeding 50 kilos (112 lbs.);
 (b) In bulk, with the written permission of the inspector.

PART V.—POTATOES.

15. *New Potatoes* intended for export to any destination shall be packed in one of the following manners :—

- (i) In wooden cases having a standard net weight $30\frac{1}{4}$ kilos (say 72 lbs.), lined with paper. The potatoes shall be protected with moist peat moss. The cases shall—

(a) be constructed of timber of the following thicknesses :—

Ends	16 mm.
Top, bottom and side staves	7 mm.

(b) be of the following dimensions :—

Internal height	24 cm.
Internal width	34 cm.
External length	68 cm.

- (ii) In new small baskets having the specifications and dimensions set out in Regulation 5 (4) of the Regulations, lined with paper. The potatoes shall be protected with wood wool or a similar material at the top and bottom of the baskets.

16. *Ware Potatoes* intended for export to any destination other than ports of the Mediterranean Sea, the Red Sea or the Persian Gulf or to Aden shall be packed in one of the following manners :—

- (i) In wooden cases as prescribed in clause 15 (i) above ; or
 (ii) In new small baskets as prescribed in clause 15 (ii) above ; or
 (iii) In new hessian bags, the contents of which must be of a standard gross weight of 25 kilos (56 lbs.) ; or
 (iv) In wooden crates of any dimensions approved by the Director ; or
 (v) In cartons of specifications and dimensions approved by the Director.

17. *Ware Potatoes* intended for export to ports of the Mediterranean Sea, the Red Sea or the Persian Gulf or to Aden, and not intended for transshipment to any other destination, may be packed in any of the manners prescribed in paragraph 16 above or in one of the following manners :—

- (i) In new hessian bags, the contents of which must be of a standard gross weight of 50 kilos (112 lbs.).
 (ii) In new large baskets having the specifications and dimensions set out in Regulation 5 (4) (ii) of the Regulations, lined with paper. The potatoes shall be protected with wood wool or similar material at the top and bottom of the basket.

PART VI.—ONIONS.

18. *Onions* intended for export to any destination other than ports of the Mediterranean Sea, the Red Sea or the Persian Gulf or to Aden, and onion picklers and *onion sets* intended for export to any destination shall be packed in one of the following manners :—

- (i) In well ventilated wooden cases or crates or trays conforming with the provisions of Regulation 5 of the Regulations, of any dimensions approved by the Director, provided that onion picklers and onion sets shall be packed in bags within the case, crate or tray as the case may be.
- (ii) In new open mesh bags or new netting bags of a standard gross weight of 25 kilos (56 lbs.).

19. *Onions* intended for export to ports of the Mediterranean Sea, the Red Sea or the Persian Gulf or to Aden, provided they are not intended for transshipment to other destination, may alternatively be packed in new open bags or new netting bags of a gross weight not exceeding 50 kilos (112 lbs.).

REVOCATION.

The Notice under Notification No. 174 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of 17th March, 1955, is hereby revoked without prejudice to anything done or left undone thereunder.
