THE CURFEWS LAWS, 1955.

LAWS 17 AND 47 OF 1955.

ORDER MADE UNDER SECTION 2.

In exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by section 2 of the Curfews Laws, 1955, and delegated to me under section 2A of the said Laws by Notification No. 666 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 19th July, 1956, I do hereby order as follows :—

1. This Order may be cited as the Curfews (Limassol District No. 3) Order, 1957.

2. Within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto no Greek or Turkish Cypriot male or female person born on or after January the 1st, 1930, shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Limassol or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, the Cyprus Police Force or any Government employee.

This Order shall come into force on the 9th day of February, 1957.

Within the Municipal boundaries of Limassol town.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

From 05.00 hours on Saturday the 9th February, 1957 until 09.00 hours on Sunday the 10th February, 1957.

2. Within the area prescribed in the First Schedule hereto no Greek Cypriot male or female person born on or after January the 1st, 1930, shall be out of doors between the hours prescribed in the Second Schedule hereto except under the authority of a written permit granted by the Commissioner of Limassol or the Assistant Chief Constable in charge of the area :

Provided that this Order shall not apply to any member of the Executive Council, Her Majesty's Forces, the Cyprus Police Force or any Government employee,
