THE LAND ACQUISITION LAW.

CAP. 233 AND LAWS 26 OF 1952, 43 OF 1955 AND 22 OF 1956.

NOTIFICATION UNDER SECTION 7.

Whereas by Notification No. 124 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 23rd February, 1956, the Governor declared the widening, improving and realigning of the public road between Famagusta and Larnaca to be an undertaking of public utility;

And whereas the Commissioner of Larnaca in compliance with section 6 of the Land Acquisition Law, by a notice published under Notification No. 489 in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th April, 1957, gave particulars of a portion of the lands required in connection with the aforesaid undertaking (hereinafter referred to as "the lands");

And whereas the Commissioner of Larnaca forwarded to the Governor the required recommendations, plan and particulars no objections having been made;

And whereas the Governor has approved the plan and particulars submitted, and has considered it expedient, having regard to the circumstances of the case, that the lands be acquired:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 7 of the Land Acquisition Law, the Governor hereby sanctions the acquisition of the lands under the provisions of the said Law.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 3) 1957.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

Whereas it appears to me to be expedient in the interest of public order and safety to take possession of the land described in the Schedule hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the land") and to authorize its use in the interest of public order and safety:

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1957, which I have been authorized to exercise under Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the Gazette of the 26th November, 1955, I, the Commissioner of Nicosia and Kyrenia, hereby take possession of the land and in connection with the taking possession and making use of the land, I hereby direct and order as follows:—

- (1) The use of the land for the requirements of Her Majesty's Forces is hereby authorized.
- (2) The persons using the land in pursuance of this Order are hereby authorized to do, in relation to the land, anything which any person having an interest in the land would be entitled to do by virtue of that interest.

(3) The exercise of any right of way over the land, and of any other right relating thereto which is enjoyed by any person, whether by virtue of an interest in the land or otherwise, is hereby prohibited.

SCHEDULE.

The privately owned land situated at Karavas village, Kyrenia District, that is to say:—

The area under plot Nos. 56/2/7, 56/2/9, 56/2/10, 56/2/3, 56/2/2, 56/2/1, 58, 59 and part of plots 60 and 85/2 of the Government Survey Plan XII.10.E more particularly defined as the area coloured red on the plan signed by the Assistant Director of Hirings on the 16th May, 1957, and deposited in the office of the Commissioner, Nicosia and Kyrenia.

THE EMERGENCY POWERS (PUBLIC SAFETY AND ORDER) REGULATIONS, 1955 TO (No. 3) 1957.

ORDER MADE UNDER REGULATION 44.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in the Governor by Regulation 44 of the Emergency Powers (Public Safety and Order) Regulations, 1955 to (No. 3) 1957, and delegated to me under Notification No. 736 published in Supplement No. 3 to the *Gazette* of the 26th November, 1955, I, Robert Chattan Ross-Clunis, Commissioner of Limassol, do order that the aforesaid authorization for using the property by the security forces subject to the restrictions and conditions laid down in the Order be continued for a further period of six months as from the expiration of the Order, and the Order is so extended accordingly.
