## ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2946 MADE UNDER SECTION 3.

Cap. 58

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 3 of the Change of Titles Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order that the titles in the second column of the Schedule hereto shall be substituted for the titles set out opposite thereto in the third column of the said Schedule, in respect of the Departments set out, respectively, in the first column of the said Schedule, wherever they appear in any enactment and in any book or document whatsoever in use in any Department of the Government.
