THE PENSIONS LAW.

CAP. 288 AND LAWS 4 OF 1952, 1 OF 1955 AND 29 OF 1956.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2947

MADE UNDER SECTION 2 (1).

In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 (1) of the Pensions Law, His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Pensionable Offices (Declaration) (Consolidation) Order, 1957.

2. The offices set out in the Schedule hereto are declared to be pensionable offices for the purposes of the Pensions Law.

3. All offices at any time hitherto declared pensionable other than the offices set out in the Schedule hereto are declared to be no longer pensionable, due regard being had to existing rights.

4. The Pensionable Offices (Declaration and Consolidation) Orders, 1952 to 1956 are hereby revoked.

THE CONSULAR CONVENTIONS LAW, 1952.

ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2948

MADE UNDER SECTION 8 (1).

Whereas by section 8 (1) of the Consular Conventions Law, 1952 (hereinafter referred to as "the Law") it is enacted that the Governor may, by Order-in-Council, direct that sections 2, 4, 6 or 7 of the Law shall apply to any foreign state specified in the Order, being a state with which a consular convention providing for matters for which provision is made by those sections has been concluded by Her Majesty:
