In exercise of the powers vested in him by section 18 of the Steam Boilers, Engines and Receivers Law, His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to make the following regulations :—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Steam Boilers, Engines and Receivers (Amendment) Regulations, 1957, and shall be read as one with the Steam Boilers, Engines and Receivers Regulations (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Regulations”).

2. The proviso to Regulation 17 of the principal legislation as set out in Regulation 3 of the Steam Boilers, Engines and Receivers (Amendment) Regulations, 1955, is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words “Secretary for Social Services” (line 4) and the substitution therefor of the words “Administrative Secretary”.
