### ORDER IN COUNCIL No. 2956

MADE UNDER SECTION 12 (3).

Whereas by sub-section (3) of section 12 of the Dangerous Drugs Law, 1956, power is conferred on the Governor by Order in Council to apply 20 of 1956 Part III of the said Law with such modifications as may be specified in the Order, to any of the following drugs, that is to say, methylmorphine (commonly known as codeine), ethylmorphine (commonly known as dionin) and their respective salts (hereinafter referred to as "the said drugs"):

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by sub-section (3) of section 12 of the Dangerous Drugs Law, 1956, His Excellency the 20 of 1956 Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order as follows:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Application of Law) Order, 1957, and shall come into operation on the 9th day of September, 1957.
- 2. Part III of the Dangerous Drugs Law, 1956, shall, with the modifi- 20 of 1956 cations specified in the Schedule hereto, apply to the said drugs.
