## THE ELECTRICITY DEVELOPMENT (STOCK) REGULATIONS, 1958.

#### (P.I. No. 1094 of 1958).

Whereas under the provisions of section 18 of the Electricity Development Law, 1952, the Electricity Authority of Cyprus with the consent of the Governor has resolved to borrow three hundred thousand pounds on the issue of Electricity Development (Third Issue) Stock, 1967, pursuant to section 19 of the said Law and as hereinafter provided :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by paragraph (1) of Regulation 3 of the Electricity Development (Stock) Regulations, 1958, the Governor hereby amends the Schedule to the said Regulations to provide an additional issue of stock by adding at the end thereof the new item following :—

"Description of Stock	Amount	Rate of interest per annum $5\frac{1}{2}\%$	Date of Redemption
Electricity Development (Third Issue) Stock, 1967.	£300,000		1st January, 1967, to 31st December, 1967."

# No. 634. THE BOMBARDMENT RANGE AREAS LAW. CAP. 222 AND LAWS 23 OF 1951 AND 38 OF 1958.

#### Notice under Section 2.

Whereas in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 of the Bombardment Range Areas Law, as contained in the Bombardment Range Areas (Amendment) Law, 1951, His Excellency the Governor declared the areas set out in the Schedule to this Notice to be Bombardment Range Areas ; And whereas the periods of validity of the declarations aforesaid were

from time to time extended :

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested in him by section 2 aforesaid His Excellency the Governor has been pleased to declare that—

- (1) the areas set out in the First Schedule to this Notice shall be Bombardment Range Areas for use by Her Majesty's Forces, with effect from the 14th day of December, 1959, and until further order, as practice areas for the use of all kinds of ammunition (including rocket projectiles) from any vessel, aircraft, vehicle, artillery weapon, firearm or any other weapon issued for use by Her Majesty's Forces, or for the dropping of live or other bombs from any aircraft or for detonations :
- (2) the areas set out in the Second Schedule to this Notice shall be Bombardment Range Areas for use by Her Majesty's Forces, with effect from the 14th day of December, 1959, and until further order, as practice areas for the use of all kinds of small arms and the ammunition therefor ;

#### FIRST SCHEDULE.

#### The Akamas Bombardment Range Area.

All that part of the Akamas Forest which lies north and west of a line, cleared of trees and bushes, which commences at the point on the sea coast nearest to Petra Kionos, which point is 370 feet north-west of the mouth of Argaki tou Koundouro Kambou River and proceeds north-eastwards for a distance of 940 feet, passing through localities "Kasia tou Konona" and "Dasosakama" to a point 1,050 feet west of locality "Glyky Mersini" thence due northwards for a distance of two miles 610 yards passing through locality "Kiladi tou Koumaroudiou", Forest Cairn No. 121, localities "Mouttalli tou Shaledes", "Spilios tou Garilli", "Fountana Amorosa", and "Spilios tis Phountanas", Triangulation Point No. 1080 to a point on the sea coast, which point is 1,200 feet northwest of Ayios Epiphanios. The said line is more particularly marked on the ground by notice boards every 1,800 feet bearing the words in English, Greek and Turkish.

#### " DANGER

#### Admiralty Bombardment Range.

Entrance is prohibited when the Red flags (or Red Lights by night) are displayed one at the Northern Extremity of the Area and one at the

highest point of the ground at the Southern extremity of the Area" and on the map 1 : 50,000 Cyprus, Sheet 1, Polis, by points map reference 050546, 072565 and 072603.

#### The Akrotiri (No. 1) Bombardment Range Area.

The boundary forms part of a circle and encloses part of AKROTIRI Main State Forest and part of the Merra of AKROTIRI in the village AKROTIRI in the District of LIMASSOL. The centre of the said circle is at a point on the seashore, the co-ordinates of which on the Survey of CYPRUS grid are x-118440, y-140750 feet. The radius of the said circle is 3,000 feet. All which said boundary is represented on the map 1 : 50,000 CYPRUS sheet 6 EPISKOPI, by a part of the circle, centre at the point, map reference 633071 and radius 1,000 yards, commencing at the point, map reference 635079, on the seashore and proceeding in a clockwise direction to the point, map reference 642063, on the seashore.

#### The Akrotiri (No. 2) Bombardment Range Area.

That area of the territorial waters of Cyprus contained inside a line drawn through the following positions on Admiralty Chart No. 2074 of the 15th October, 1954 :--

#### The Dhekelia Bombardment Range Area.

The boundary encloses part of localities "Knassa", "Phinijin", "Stenon", "Kazama", "Kokkinokremmos", "Mavrospilios", "Paliomandra", "Kimistron", "Kaphkarokremmos", "Vikla", "Loutomia" and "Laxia tou Papa" of the village of Pyla in the District of Larnaca and is marked on the ground by danger notices at intervals of 300 yards. The Cyprus Survey Grid Co-ordinates of the corners of the said boundary are E.235064, N.148504; E.235375, N.148630; E.236300, N.148780; E.236890, N.148850; E.237015, N.148555; E.236530, N.148275; E.235690, N.147820; E.235218, N.147695.

All which said boundary is marked more particularly on the ground by Danger Notices situated at prominent points warning all persons in English, Greek and Turkish that they should keep out of the area when red flags are hoisted, and on the map 1: 50,000 CYPRUS, Sheet 13, LARNACA, by a line joining the points in succession whose map references are 351485, 354487, 363488, 369489, 370486, 366483, 357478 and 35477.

The Episkopi Bombardment Range Area.

The area of the territorial waters of Cyprus bounded by a line drawn round the circumference of a circle of 3,000 yards radius with a centre in the position  $34^{\circ}38'00''N$ ,  $32^{\circ}51'40''E$  and by the limit of the territorial waters where that limit is within the area of the aforesaid circle.

The Goshi Bombardment Range Area.

The boundary is a rectangle 4,374 yards by 3,281 yards or thereabouts, the longer side lying in a grid north and south direction and the southwestern corner of the said rectangle is a point 40 yards or thereabouts northeast of another point on the Nicosia–Larnaca main road, which point is 900 yards or thereabouts southeast of mile post 17 on the said road. The said boundary includes all or part of the localities "Meghali Moutti" and "Khalkonomoutti" in the village of Goshi, all or part of the localities "Dhiplopotamos" "Zoudhia", "Loures", "Kamenos", "Kiona" and "Mandra Athieniti" in the village of Avdhellero, all or part of the localities "Katsiniaris" and "Kaokremnos" of the village of Athienou and all or part of the localities "Kamilostrata", "Mersines" and "Kondokoli", of the village of Aradhippou ; all which said villages are in the district of Larnaca.

All which said boundary is marked more particularly on the ground by Danger Notices situated at prominent points outside the boundary of the Range Area warning all persons in English, Greek and Turkish that they should keep out of the area when red flags are hoisted, and on the map I : 50,000 CYPRUS, Sheet 13, LARNACA, by a line through the points map reference 190470, 190510, 220510, and 220470.

The Larnaca Bombardment Range Area.

(1) Sea Danger Area: The area of the territorial water of Cyprus contained inside a line drawn through the following positions on Admiralty Chart No. 851 of the 8th August, 1941 :---

(2) Land Danger Area : The boundary commences at a point on the coast south of the Salt Lake ; thence north-northwest for approximately one mile ; thence northeast for approximately two miles, thence east southeast to the coast. It includes the shingle road along the coast and an area up to approximately 500 yards inland from the road.

All of which said boundary is marked more particularly on the ground by Danger Notices situated at prominent points warning all persons in English, Greek and Turkish to keep away from the Danger Area when red flags (or red lights by night) are displayed on the beach at the points marking the northern and southern limits of the Danger Area and at the Marker's Shelter situated at the eastern landward limit of the Danger Area ; and on the map 1: 50,000 CYPRUS, Sheet 13, LARNACA, by points map reference 269318, 264334, 289352 and 293351.

Lefkonico Bambardment Range Area.

The boundary commences at the Forest Cairn No. 109 of the "Kantara Main State Forest" and proceeds northeastwards in a straight line for a distance of 1,430 yards approximately to a point on the map 1 : 50,000 CYPRUS, Sheet 11, LEFKONICO, by the points map reference 406880; thence northeastwards in a straight line for a distance of 2,816 yards approximately to a point on the said map by the points map reference 431886; thence southeastwards in a straight line for a distance of 9,064 yards approximately to a point on the said map by the points map reference 480821; thence southwestwards in a straight line for a distance of 6,295 yards approximately to a point on the said map by the points map reference 430793; thence northwestwards in a straight line for a distance of 4,224 yards approximately to a point on the said map by the points map reference 392800; thence northeastwards in a straight line for a distance of 2,904 yards approximately to a point on the said map by the points map reference 401824 ; thence northwards in a straight line to the point of commencement.

All which said boundary is marked more particularly on the ground by Danger Notices situated at prominent points, warning all persons in English, Greek and Turkish that they should keep out of the area when red flags are hoisted.

#### The Pyla Bombardment Range Area.

(1) Sea Danger Area : That area of the territorial waters of Cyprus contained inside a line drawn through the following positions on Admiralty Chart No. 851 of the 8th August, 1941 :---

(2) Land Danger Area : The boundary commences at a point on the coast 500 yards due south of the Church at Panayia ; thence northeast for 2,900 yards to where the track from Xylophagou turns southeast; thence eastsoutheast for 4,000 yards to the coast at a point 400 yards due south of the Church at Ayios Yeorghios.

All which said boundary is marked more particularly on the ground by Danger Notices situated at prominent points warning all persons in English, Greek and Turkish to keep away from the Danger Area when red flags (or red lights by night) are displayed at Cape Greco, Cape Pyla and Dhekelia and on a boat patrolling outside the boundary of the sea Danger Area; and on the map 1: 50,000 CYPRUS, Sheet 13, LARNACA, and Sheet 15, FAMAGUSTA, by points map reference 470453, 495468 and 534458.

#### SECOND SCHEDULE.

Athalassa Bombardment Range Area. The boundary encloses part of localities "Dhasos tis Athalassas", "Aronas", "Nifkia" and "Argakas" of the village of Eylenja in the District of Nicosia. The said boundary consists of a rectangle and of a triangle, the base of the said triangle being one side of the said rectangle (the co-ordinates of the corners of the said rectangle are E.209200, N.164600, E.209925, N.164050, E.209475, N.163375, and E.208750, N.163900 and the co-ordinates of the apex of the said triangle are E.207750, N.165050).

All which said boundary is marked more particularly on the ground by Danger Notices situated at prominent points warning all persons in English, Greek and Turkish that they should keep out of the area when red flags are hoisted by day (or red lights are displayed by night) and on the map 1: 50,000 CYPRUS, Sheets 8, NICOSIA and 12 KYTHREA, by a line through the points map reference 078651, 092646, 099641, 095634 and 087639.

### The Karaolos Bombardment Range Area.

The boundary encloses part of localities "Titsirolimni " and " Karaolos", of Ayios Loukas Quarter of the Town of Famagusta and Varosha and part of the sea to the north and east of the mouth of the river Yalia. The said boundary consists partly of the section of a circle (the co-ordinates of the centre of the said circle are E.254643.75 m., N.166404.49 m.) of radius 642 yards or thereabouts, which sector subtends an angle of 45° or thereabouts at the said centre but excluding the isosceles triangle of base 23 yards 00000

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or thereabouts forming the apex of the said sector ; the said boundary is extended seawards by part of the sector of another circle (the co-ordinates of the centre of the said circle are E.254552.92 m., N.166023.50 m.) of radius 2,959 yards or thereabouts, which sector subtends an angle of 28° or thereabouts, at the said centre. The two sectors have a common central axis ; the grid bearing of the said axis is N.15°30'E or thereabouts, from the centres of the said circle.

All of which said boundary is marked more particularly on the ground by Danger Notices situated at prominent points warning all persons in English, Greek and Turkish that they should keep out of the area when red flags are hoisted by day (or red lights are displayed by night) and on the map 1 : 50,000 CYPRUS, Sheet 15, FAMAGUSTA by a line through the points map reference 546664, 545670, 546687, 552686, 558684 and 550669. The Polemidhia Bombardment Range Area.

The boundary commences on the easternside of the road from Limassol to Paramytha, 300 feet northwest of the northwestern corner of plot No. 102 of the Government Survey Plan No. L11/32, locality "Mersinia" and proceeds south-eastwards in a straight line to the most western point of Plot No. 127 of the Government Survey Plan No. L111/40, locality "Laxia"; thence south-eastwards in a straight line to the most southern point of Plot No. 147 of the said plan, locality "Symadhia"; thence southwards in a straight line to the Forest Cairn No. 5 Polemidhia Forest ; thence northwestwards in a straight line to the most western point of Plot No. 158 of the Government Survey Plan No. L111/48, locality "Afendika"; thence north-westwards in a straight line to the most western point of Plot No. 60 of the Government Survey Plan No. L111/40, locality "Kitromili"; thence north-westwards in a straight line to the north-eastern corner of Plot No. 4 of the said plan, locality "Manitarka"; thence north-eastwards in a straight line to the point of commencement.

All which said boundary is marked more particularly on the ground by Danger Notices situated at prominent points warning all persons in English, Greek and Turkish that they should keep out of the area when red flags are hoisted by day (or red lights are displayed by night) on the map 1 : 50,000 CYPRUS, Sheets 6 and 10 LIMASSOL by a line through the points map reference (Military Grid) R.697202, R.706189, R.709182, R.710175, R.701182, R.698185 and R.690197.
