THE POLICE LAW, 1958.

REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 10.

In exercise of the powers vested in me by section 10 of the Police Law, 1958, I, the Acting Chief Constable, with the approval of the Governor, do hereby make the following regulations:—

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (Discipline) (Amendment) Regulations, 1960, and shall be read as one with the Police (Discipline) Regulations, 1958 and 1959 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations").
- 2. The definition of "Presiding Officer" in paragraph (1) of regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the word "Gazetted" (line 1).
- 3. The definition of "second-in-command" in paragraph (1) of regulation 2 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended by the deletion therefrom of the words "Gazetted Officer" (line 2) and the substitution therefor of the words "Officer not below the rank of Chief Inspector".
- 4. Paragraph (2) of regulation 14 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows:—
 - (a) by the deletion therefrom of the words "A Gazetted Officer" (line 1) and the substitution therefor of the words "An Officer not below the rank of Chief Inspector";
 - (b) by the deletion from the second proviso thereto of the words "the Divisional Commander of the Division in which the accused is serving at the time of the investigation" (lines 3 and 4) and the substitution therefor of the words "a Divisional Commander who is a Gazetted Officer".
- 5. Paragraph (4) of regulation 18 of the principal Regulations is hereby amended as follows:—
 - (a) by the deletion therefrom of the words "Gazetted Officer" (line 1) and the substitution therefor of the words "Presiding Officer";
 - (b) by the insertion therein, immediately after the words "Divisional Commander" (line 3), of the words and commas ", if such Divisional Commander is of a rank senior to that of the Presiding Officer,".
